Powerschool Enrollment Forms

1. Click the Create Account tab
2. Click Create Account.

3. Enter the information needed to create your account. The email address you enter is used to send email notifications, including account recovery notices and account changes confirmations.

4. For each of your students, enter the Access ID and Access Password that is below and your relationship to the student.

Click Enter.

5. Check your email for a verification message and click the link within the email to sign in to your PowerSchool account within 24 hours of receiving the message. If the link has expired, you can request a new link be emailed to you.

Enter your Username and Password.

Click Sign In.

Student Behavior

We've noticed an increase in undesired student behavior this school year, including class disruption, disrespect and defiance. Our 6th grade classroom has been piloting a behavior management program titled "CHAMPS" this year and it is highly effective. We will be implementing this CHAMPS program school-wide effective immediately. There will be more information coming from your students' teacher this week. Essentially the program consists of setting clear expectations for behavior and following up with a structured warning system starting with a whole group reminder, several individual reminders for a student and then parent contact. It follows our default behavior management system but is more structured and when used with fidelity works exceptionally well.
